Have you ever felt overwhelmed by the number of people involved, the process that is set in front of you, and the lengthy document that is created to “help your child succeed”? Come and hear the 10 most important things you should know about IEPs. Hear strategies on what to expect, how things should go, and what to do when you feel the IEP team is not doing what is in the best interest of your child. Amy Wall is an educational consultant/advocate servicing the Northern Virginia Area. She also works with homeschool families to develop strong programs for their children with special needs. Amy has two siblings with special needs and now has 6 children, 2 of whom have special needs themselves.
